1. MARRIED WOMAN REGISTERING AN ILLEGITIMATE CHILD

FEE: \$16

Section 6 of the Registrar General's Births and Deaths Regulation

Decision maker: Registrar General

- Letter of application by mother of subject child (biological father may be joined to the application if he intends to register child)
- Affidavit in support by mother (and biological father if joined)
Must include the following:
 - When mother was married (and children of marriage if any)
 - When mother separated from husband or if separation was temporary, specific period in question
 - When co-habitation with biological father occur and where
 - Who was aware of relationship (independent witness) and how
 - Full name of child, date of birth, place of birth, gender
 - Declare that the sexual relations with bio-father was exclusive and husband did not have access
 - Details to support application to dispense service on husband
 - Confirmation of family name with which subject child is to be registered
- Affidavit in support by witness to cohabitation (proving that parties had no access to each other when child could have been conceived as required by Practice Direction 3/ 2007)
- Affidavit from husband denying paternity (if available)
- Certificate of Live Birth from hospital (original or re-issued)
- Certificate of baptism or church membership record (if any)
- Original Marriage Certificate of mother or Decree Absolute if available
- Evidence of service of petition on husband (apply to dispense service on husband – to be stated in affidavit outlining relevant grounds)

Faitu'utu'uni: Failesisita Seniale

- Tohi kole mei he fa'e 'o e tokotaha ke lesisita (malava ke fakakau 'a e tamai fakanatula 'o kapau 'oku taumu'a ke kau he lesisita 'o e tokotaha ke lesisita)
- Fuakava poupou 'o e fa'e (mo e tamai fakanatula kapau 'oku kau he tohi kole)
Kuo pau ke fakaha ai eni:
 - 'Aho na'e mali ai 'a e fa'e (mo e fanau mali kapau 'oku 'iai)
 - Taimi na'e mavae ai mei he husepaniti pea kapau na'e mavae fakataimi, fakapapau'i mai 'a e vaha'a taimi ne fai ai 'a e mavae
 - Na'e kamata fakaku 'a e nonofo fakamali mo e tamai fakanatula pea na'e nonofo fakamali 'i fe
 - Ko hai 'a e tokotaha na'e 'ilo kihe nonofo fakamali mo e tamai fakanatula pea na'e angafefe 'ene 'ilo (fakamo'oni tau'ataina)
 - Hingoa kakato 'o e tokotaha ke lesisita, 'aho fa'ele'i, feitu'u na'e fa'ele'i ai, tangata pe fefine
 - Fakaha mahino na'e 'ikai pe ko e toe nonofo fakamali mo hono husepaniti 'i he vaha'a taimi ko eni ne fanau'i ai 'a e tokotaha ke lesisita

- Kapau 'oku kole ke fakatatafe 'a e ngaahi fiema'u ki he husepaniti, 'omai 'a e makatu'unga mo e ngaahi fakamatala fakaikiiki ke pou pou kiai

- Fakapapau'i mai 'a e hingoa 'oku loto ke tohi 'aki 'a e tokotaha ke lesisita

- Fuakava pou pou mei he fakamo'oni tau'atana ki he nonofo fakamali (fakaha mahino ai na'e 'ikai pe toe 'iai ke toe nonofo fakamali 'a e fa'e pea mo hono husepaniti 'i he vaha'a taimi ko eni ne fanau'i ai 'a e tokotaha ke lesisita 'o hange koia 'oku fiema'u 'e he Ngaahi Tu'utu'uni (Practice Direction 3/2007)
- Fuakava pou pou mei he husepaniti 'o fakamo'oni 'oku 'ikai ko e tamai ia 'o e tokotaha ke lesisita ('okapau 'e ma'u)
- Tohi Certificate of Live Birth mei falemahaki (original pe re-issued)
- Tohi papi pe lekooti siasi ('oka 'iai)
- Tatau mo'oni (original) 'o e Tohi Mali 'o e fa'e pe ko e Tohi Vete kapau kuo vete
- Fakamo'oni kuo tufa 'a e tohi kole 'i he husepaniti (pe koe kole ke fakatatafe 'a e ngaahi fiema'u – ke fakaha 'i he fuakava pea mo hono ngaahi fakaikiiki)

FEE: \$16

Decision maker: Sub-registrar

Letter of application by mother of subject child (biological father may be joined to the application if he intends to register child)

Affidavit in support by mother (and biological father if joined)

Must include the following:

- Declaration by mother that there were no access between her and husband
- Confirm that child is not husband's biological child
- Name of biological father

Affidavit from husband denying paternity (if available)

Certificate of Live Birth from hospital (original or re-issued)

Certificate of baptism or church membership record (if any)

Decree Absolute (original)

TOTONGI: \$16

Faitu'utu'uni: Tokoni Failesisita

Tohi kole mei he fa'e 'o e tokotaha ke lesisita (fakakau 'a e tamai kapau 'oku taumu'a ke ne lesisita 'a e tokotaha ke lesisita)

Fuakava pou pou 'o e fa'e (mo e tamai kapau 'oku kau he tohi kole)

Kuo pau ke fakaha ai eni:

- Fakamo'oni fakapapau na'e 'ikai toe nonofo 'a e fa'ee mo e husepaniti

- Fakamo'oni 'oku 'ikai ko e tamai fakanatula 'o e tokotaha ke lesisita 'a e husepaniti

- Fakaha e hingoa 'o e tamai
